GENERAL COUNCIL MEETING

The Minister of Education, Recreation and Sports, Sébastien Proulx, was present in the morning of November 26 to talk with parents. This constructive exchange enabled the Minister and his team to note your requests and concerns in the context of a Québec student success policy.

At the General Council meeting, the delegates were invited to take stock of the positions expressed by the parents who had answered the Fédération's on-line questionnaire. They also gave their views on the various proposals brought forward by the Minister. The delegates also made additional proposals as well as comments on parent expectations.

The results of the consultative and deliberative process will be presented in a brief tabled by the FCPQ for the Québec-wide consultation on educational success on December 1 and 2, 2016.

The three workshops attended by the delegates present concerned the three thrusts proposed by the Minister for his public consultations.

The parents also had the opportunity to hear and chat with Égide Royer, who gave a talk entitled *La persévérance scolaire et le Québec : susciter l'audace, cultiver la réussite*. Mr. Royer made the presentation available to all parents. It was given to the delegates in attendance and posted on the FCPQ's website and on Facebook.
